- Denotes 1/2" steel reinforcing rods tagged L.S. 2902 and found on this survey.

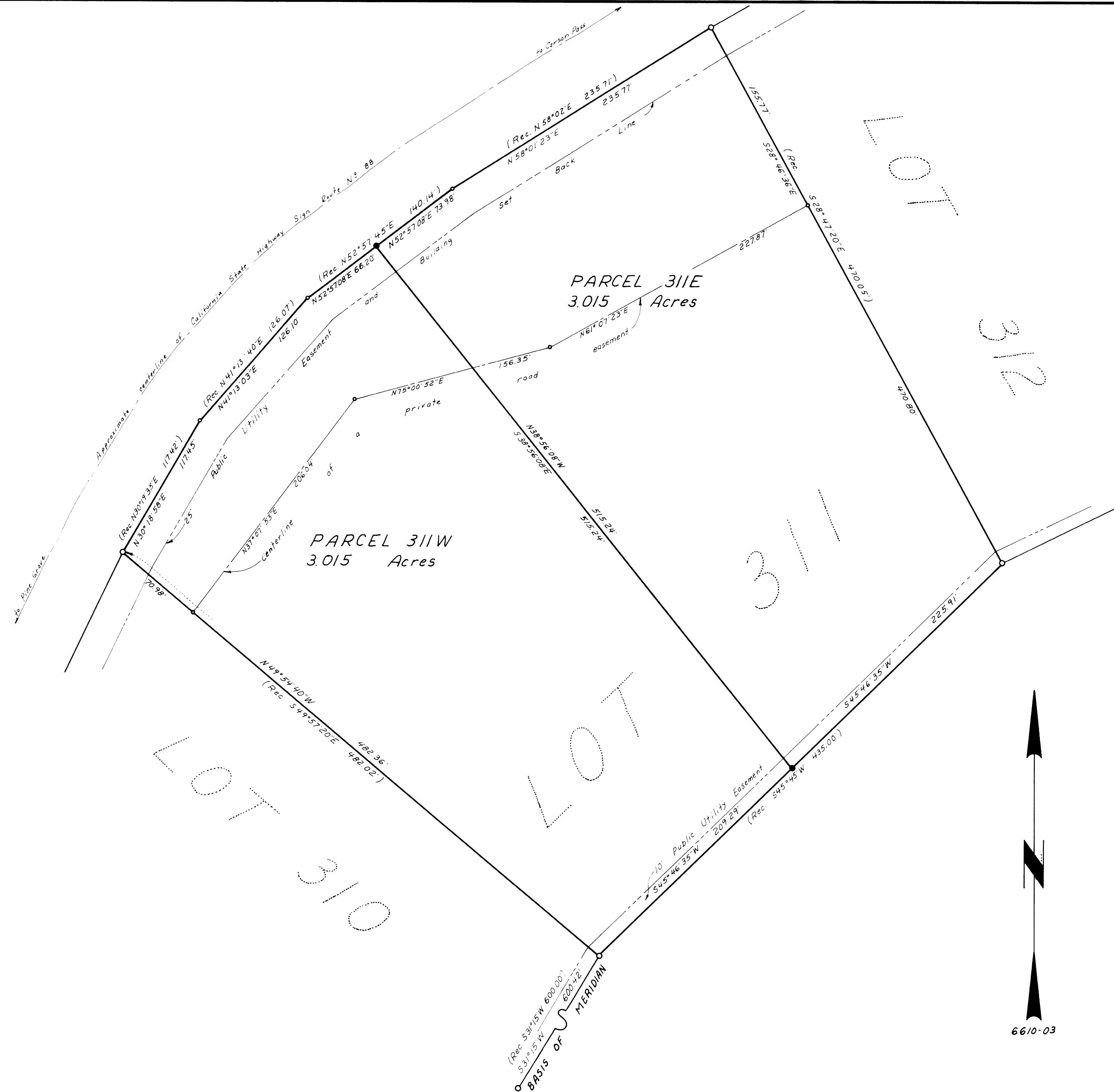
