## **Adjective**

## **Meaning:**

Gigantic, colossal; tremendous in size, volume or degree; cosmic; elephantine, enormous; gigantic; mammoth; titanic

## **Usage:**

The gargantuan Statue of Unity is twice the Statue of Liberty

# obscurantism

**Noun**

**Meaning:**

A policy of opposition to enlightenment or the spread of knowledge; a deliberate attempt to make something obscure; opposition to the spread of knowledge

**Usage:**

He was shot dead in open court, an early martyr in the struggle against obscurantism



# obscurant

(*ŏb-skūr'ănt*) *NOUN*  
ONE WHO HINDERS PROGRESS  
OF KNOWLEDGE AND FREEDOM  
OF THOUGHT.

# extolling

## Meaning:

Praise enthusiastically; eulogize

## Usage:

They are extolling the values of the leader today but previously they were only a thorn on the way of the leader

# phishing

## Noun

## Meaning:

The fraudulent practice of sending emails purporting to be from reputable companies in order to induce individuals to reveal personal information, such as passwords and credit card numbers

## Usage:

Phishing emails have plagued corporate inboxes for years. They dupe unsuspecting employees into revealing their account information which can lead to data breaches



# promptitude

**Noun**

**Meaning:**

The quality or habit of being prompt; the characteristic of doing things without delay; celerity, rapidness

**Usage:**

His chronic tardiness has put him in poor standing with his boss, who values hustle and promptitude

(prŏmp'tĭ-tūd) *noun*  
**Q**UANTITY OR HABIT OF BECOM-  
ING PROMPT; QUICKNESS  
IN DECIDING, ACTING, ETC.
